Fall Year 2

PHC 6930 – Integrative Seminar in Public Health (3)*

*A student may take PHC 6930 (Integrative Seminar) the same semester as PHC 6945 (Practicum in Public Health) with their department advisor and practicum advisor approval.

Spring Year 2

PHC 6063C – Health Policy Database

Graduation Requirements:

1. Satisfy all University requirements for Master of Public Health in Health Policy and Management.
2. Complete a minimum of 45 semester hours of graduate level coursework in approved program.

3. Earn a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 in all coursework completed.

***PHC 6945 and PHC 6930 are pass/fail and will not contribute to your GPA.**

4. Resolve incomplete grades prior to graduation. Resolve failing grades of required coursework prior to graduation.

5. Apply for graduation online at my.fiu.edu. (See Univ. Grad Catalog for most current deadlines).

6. Complete Robert Stempel School of Public Health Exit Survey prior to graduation.

7. All work applicable to the degree must be completed within six years of first enrollment in the master's program.
