Students are admitted into the Ph.D. Program only in the fall semester. <u>Applications for admission should be received to the School of Social Work by February</u> <u>1rst</u>.

Applications submitted after that date are considered as space permits.

To be considered for admission, all applicants must submit the following required application materials:

- FIU Online Application (See the link above)
 - □ This is also where you will identify references and ask them to upload a letter.
- Official transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate work
- <u>Personal statement (4-6 pages.)</u> Three letters of recommendation (two academic and one professional.
- Two examples of scholarly written work
- Please also upload or email us a copy of unofficial transcripts for review while we await your official transcripts.

All of these materials may be uploaded to the online system except for official transcripts. All materials do not need to be uploaded all at once. Students are encouraged to complete their application, and upload documents as soon as they are available. However, instructions for sending transcripts are included in the online application. Or they may be sent to the address at the bottom of this flier.

- Official translations in English for non-English transcripts/documents
- Proof of language proficiency: Applicants from non-English speaking countries, including internationally educated American students, must demonstrate proficiency in English.
 FIU only accepts test scores sent directly from the testing agency as official. The minimum score requirements are a total overall score of 80 on the iBT or 550 on the PBT, or a 6.5 overall
