

Advising, Registration, Academic Progress

- Advising: meeting with advisor twice a year to discuss courses
- After the advising meeting, you will be asked to confirm via email that you would like us to enroll you in the courses. Once you confirm, Ms. Zoraya Arguello will register you for the courses.

IMPORTANT: You do NOT register for courses yourself on MyFIU.

- You will be enrolled only in the courses that you request. Once we enroll you, you will receive an email confirmation of enrollment.
- You must then process payment for the courses by the published university deadline to avoid cancellation of enrollment.



The Practicum – Applied Practice Experience –

- Culminating experience
- Applying education & training within an agency/entity/organization
- Temporary position (200 hours need to be completed)
- Requirements:
 - At least 30 credits completed*
 - Approval by Practicum Instructor
 - Completed and approved forms
 - Form A: Education Plan
 - Form B: Preceptor Agreement
 - Letter of internship offer / establishment of Affiliation Agreement

*Accelerated students must begin this process during their FIRST semester



Do not leave the subject line blank. Do not use your personal e-mail account. Treat your professor with respect. "Hey" "Yo" and "What's up" are not acceptable greetings. Always proofread before sending. Avoid spelling and grammar mistakes. Don't use texting language and emojis when communicating with your professor.

Dear Professor Smith,

I'm in your 8:30 GEB class on Tues/Thu. I wanted to let you know that I will miss Thursday's class because I have a doctor's appointment. I already consulted the syllabus and finished the required reading for that day. I will return to class the following week. Thank you,

First Name, Last Name, Panther ID

Be clear about the reason for your e-mail in the subject line. Use your FIU e-mail address. Formally greet your professor with title and last name. Be respectful and polite. Clearly state the course you are in. Close your e-mail with a brief thank you and full name.

Career Prep Starts Today! Communicating with Your Professors

- Use and check your FIU email
 - Do not use your <u>2cute4u@something.com</u> or <u>McLovin@something.com</u>
- Informative subject line
- Begin with a formal greeting
- No text-like (slang, emoticons, abbreviations)
 - ie: How r u?, Thx 4 ur help, idk what 2 rite
- Ask clear questions or provide clear statements
 - Be concise and professional
- Check your grammar (punctuation, spelling)
 - Grammarly
- Close email properly and include your name and panther ID
 - Sincerely, Best Regards, Thank you

Me re-reading my email to a teacher for the 27th time before sending to make sure I sound professional enough
