Overview:

Requirements/Eligibility:

- ❖ Stempel College public health students
- ❖ Students will be encouraged to participate for the life of the project; i.e., for 3-4 semesters, but a single semester will be sufficient for eligibility.
- ❖ Each student will be assigned one of the neighborhood priority health conditions, with considerations for cultural competence.
