5. Meet with Academic Advisor *each Fall and Spring semester* (Departmental graduation requirement).

7. Complete Robert Stempel School of Public Health Exit Survey prior to graduation.
8. All work applicable to the degree must be completed within six years of first enrollment in the master's program.
